**Definitions:**

**Section 01:** *In Person (IP) - Course Delivery will be in person synchronous.*

**Section 06:** *Equity- USDA Equity Students identified by Liberal Studies Department*

**Section 07:** *Dual Enrollment- High School Students enrolled in college-level courses delivered at local high schools.*

**Section 11:** *Asynchronous (ASY) - Students will work online, independently while meeting all assignments due dates. Instructors will provide feedback and guidance throughout the learning process. Students must refer to the course syllabi and course schedule.*

*(additional courses with same section are H1, H2, H3 or H4)*

**Blended Course (BL) - A course that allows a portion of students to be in the classroom and a portion of the students will join via video conferencing at the same time.**

**Section 12:** *Online course (OL) - An asynchronous course offered online only. Students will have to attend scheduled time.*

*(additional courses with same section are L1, L2, L3 or L4)*

**Hybrid Course (SYN or ASY) - Course delivery will have Synchronous and Asynchronous components, with one day of in-person contact per week.**

**Synchronous (SYN) - Online learning in which the participant interacts at a scheduled class time using a video conferencing such as Zoom or Google Meets. Students must attend class during this time.**
