BFCC STUDENT FILMMAKER SHINES AFTER SUCCESS IN AIHEC FILM CONTEST

Blackfeet Community College student Melisa Trombley has achieved national recognition after her entry in the AIHEC Film Festival advanced to the Tribal College Journal Student Film Contest, where her short documentary Reconnecting with Our Ways won Best Student Film. This award opened the door for Melisa to attend and represent BFCC at the 9th Annual Pocahontas Reframed Film Festival in Richmond, Virginia.

Melisa said the experience was far more welcoming and inspiring than she ever expected.

"I expected a small turnout, but it was the complete opposite; everyone was incredibly welcoming and inclusive." She expressed deep gratitude for festival director Bradby Brown, whose support and dedication to uplifting Indigenous filmmakers left a lasting impact.

"He was kind, encouraging, and truly dedicated to supporting Indigenous voices. His guidance made the whole experience even more memorable."

Her documentary received enthusiastic praise from filmmakers and attendees alike.

'They loved the short doc and adored the interviewees. I was encouraged to continue making films, and I fully intend to." During the festival, Melisa connected with influential creatives, including Roland McCloskey—director of The Irish and Native Americans—as well as respected Indigenous filmmakers like Shelly Niro and Lauren Waters. Their encouragement energized her commitment to continue developing her craft.

"The whole experience was motivating and uplifting. It's something I will carry with me as I continue growing on my filmmaking path."

Melisa's accomplishment is a powerful example of where opportunities like AIHEC can lead. Her journey shows that BFCC students who share their stories and pursue these competitions can find themselves on national stages—and her success is just the beginning.


